(when you are on the campus.)

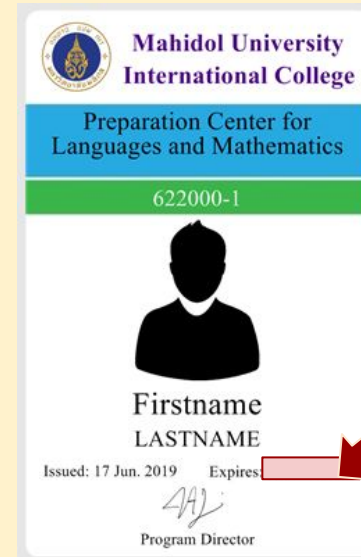

MUIC Entrance Examination



Important info to re-apply for the MUIC entrance examination

- PC students can apply for the MUIC entrance examination again at the next entry (MUIC has 4 entries per year). The new entrance examination results will be put into consideration with a student's current PC status. Students can then select the better result for acceptance.

Example: *Ms. Julia decides to apply for the MUIC Entrance Examination while studying in the PC2 level. If the Entrance Examination result shows acceptance to PC4 or MUIC, she can select to study in PC4 or MUIC and cancel her PC2 student status.*

International students require Non-Immigrant Education Visa (ED)

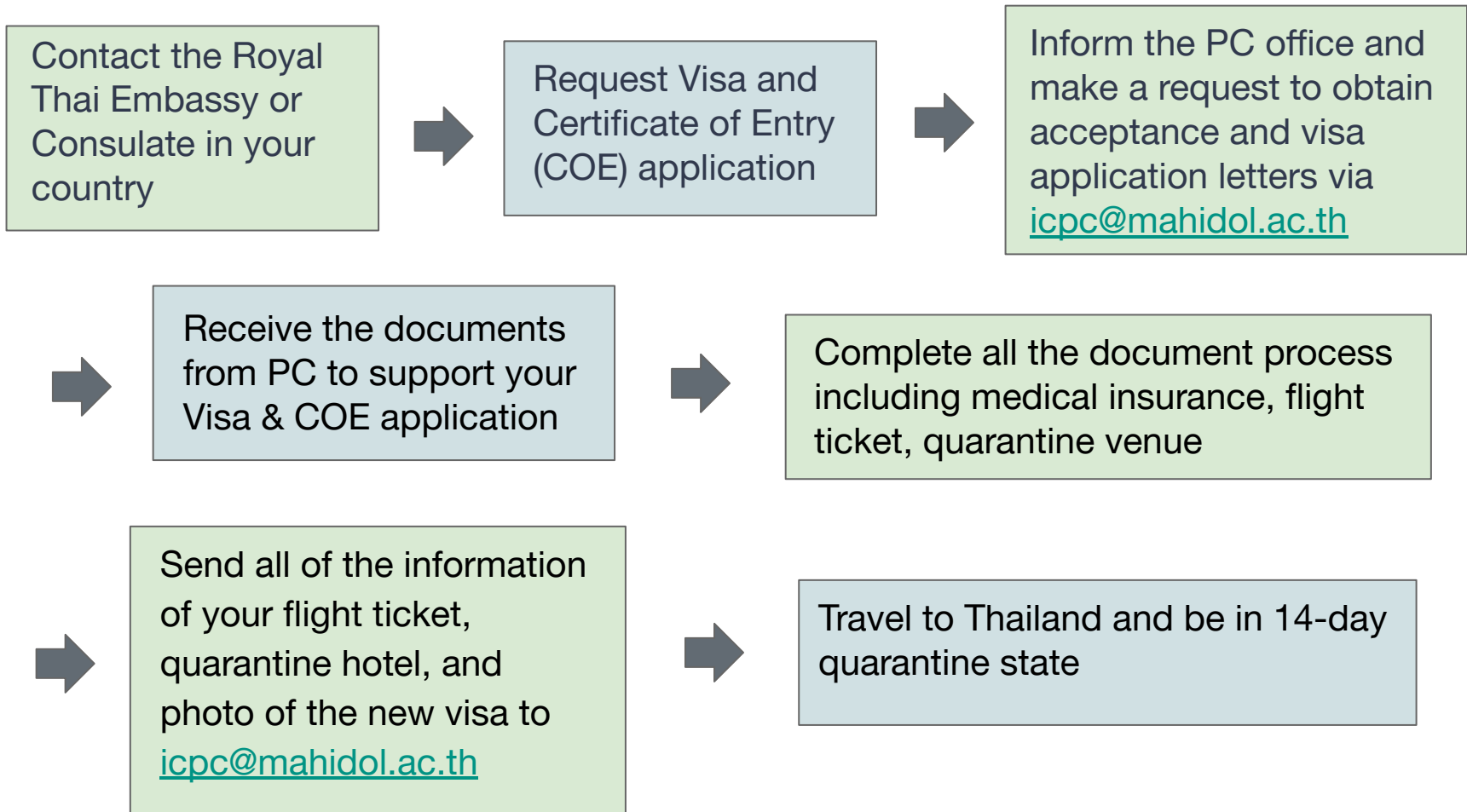
