These requirements must be completed <b>before</b> the end of the major change period.		
6	Can students change from a Bachelor of Arts (FAA) to other fields of study?	6.1 Yes, but students must complete the process in No. 3.  In addition students must study the required mathematics classes for their new major. Registration for mathematics will be based on entrance examination scores.		
7	Despite the restrictions from the BBA quota, are students still able to change their major to study in the BBA program?	7.1 Yes, but students must complete the process in No. 3. Requests may be approved if there are vacancies available in the BBA program, and students meet the BBA requirements.		
8	How much does it cost to change majors?	8.1 There is no charge the first change. However, there is a 500 baht fee for each subsequent change request. Each request must be approved by the Advisor, Chairman of the former major and new major as well as the parents or guardian(s) of the students.
