Print an invoice slip for “Studying” Registration, and use this slip to pay your registration fee at the <b>SIAM COMMERCIAL BANK (SCB) ONLY.</b></li> <li>6. The payments must take place by <b>March 9, 2017</b></li> <li>7. The invoice slip, which has been verified by bank, must be shown to PC on the admission date.</li> <li>8. Keep it until you get your receipt from pc.</b></p>
<b><u>Caution!!</u></b> Failure to comply with the above conditions will result in an incomplete registration!!	

# Late Registration

---

If students cannot register during a registration period, students must follow the steps as below:

1. Fill out the registration information and reason for the delay in the "Late Registration".
2. Click the "Send Late Registration" to confirm your registration delay. *This request must be made during the registration period.*
3. Students who register after the registration period will be charged a late payment fee per day. This late charge will not be applied to students who are waiting for the MUIC entrance exam result.

PC reserves the right to refuse a request depending on the reasons for the request.

## FAQ

---

- What should postponing students do if they are not ready to register?  
*Ans :* Students do not need to do anything. The registration system automatically keeps their results for six months or one year, depending on when their postponement starts.
- What should students do if they retake the entrance exam?  
*Ans :* - Students can compare the results and select the best one.  
- The deposit of 5,000 baht will be returned to students after the course commencement at PC or when students register as an MUIC student for six months or one year, depending on when their postponement starts.
