

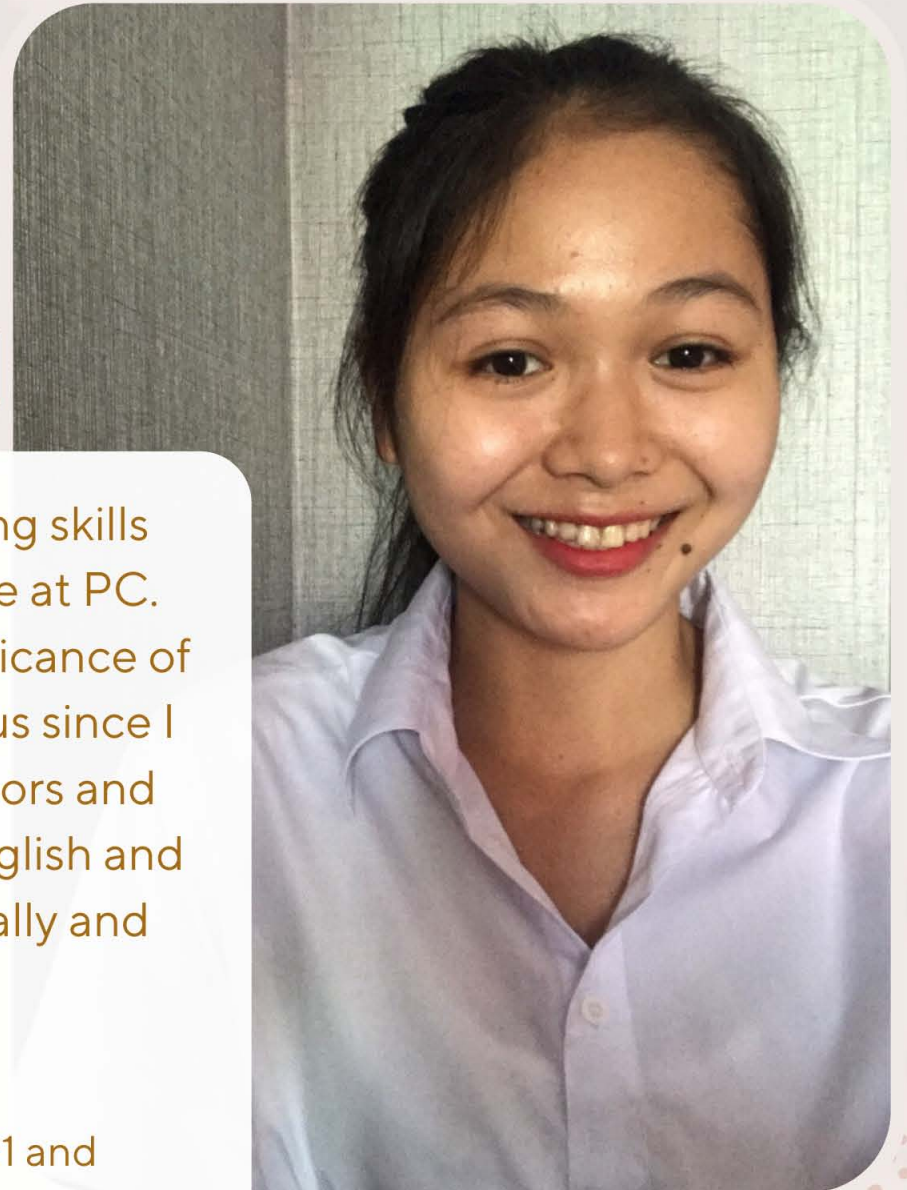


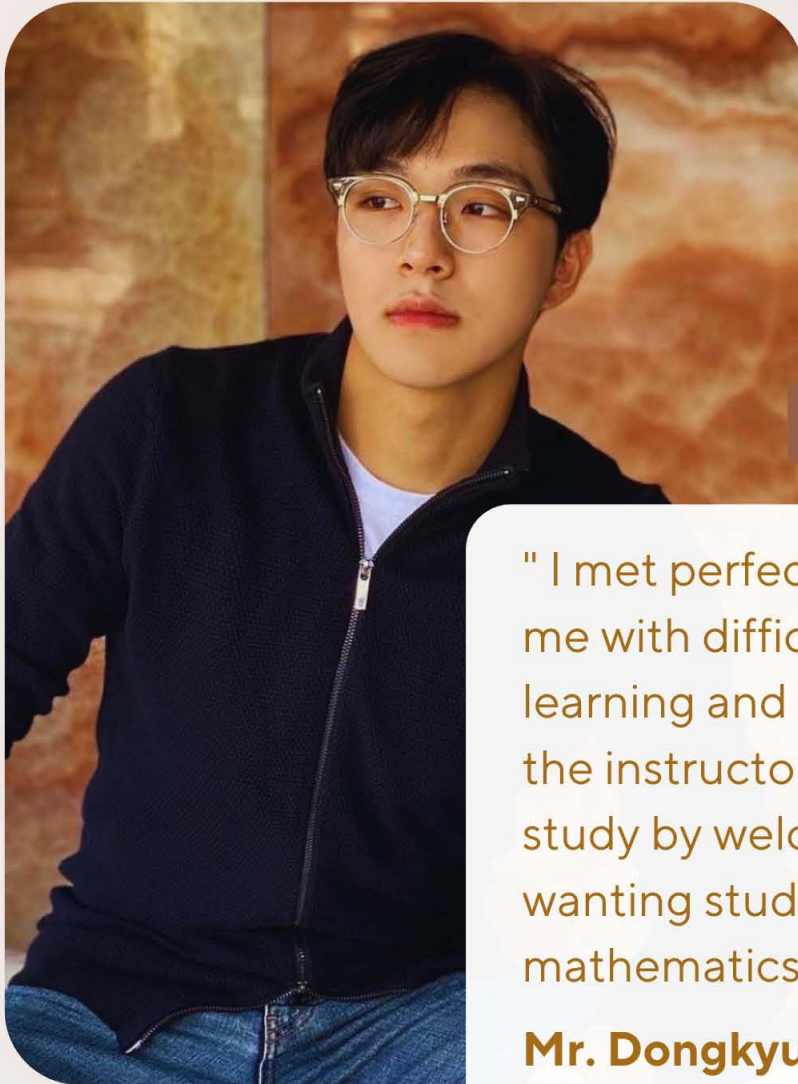
## MY TURNING POINT

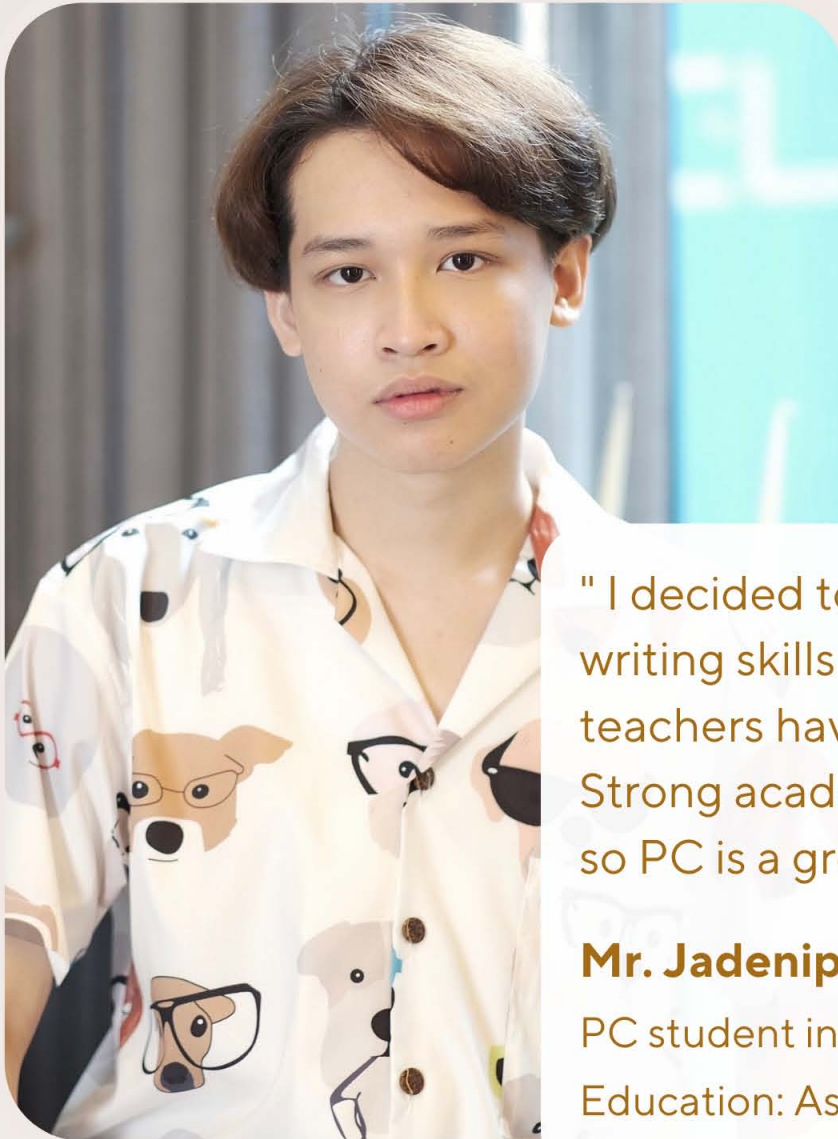

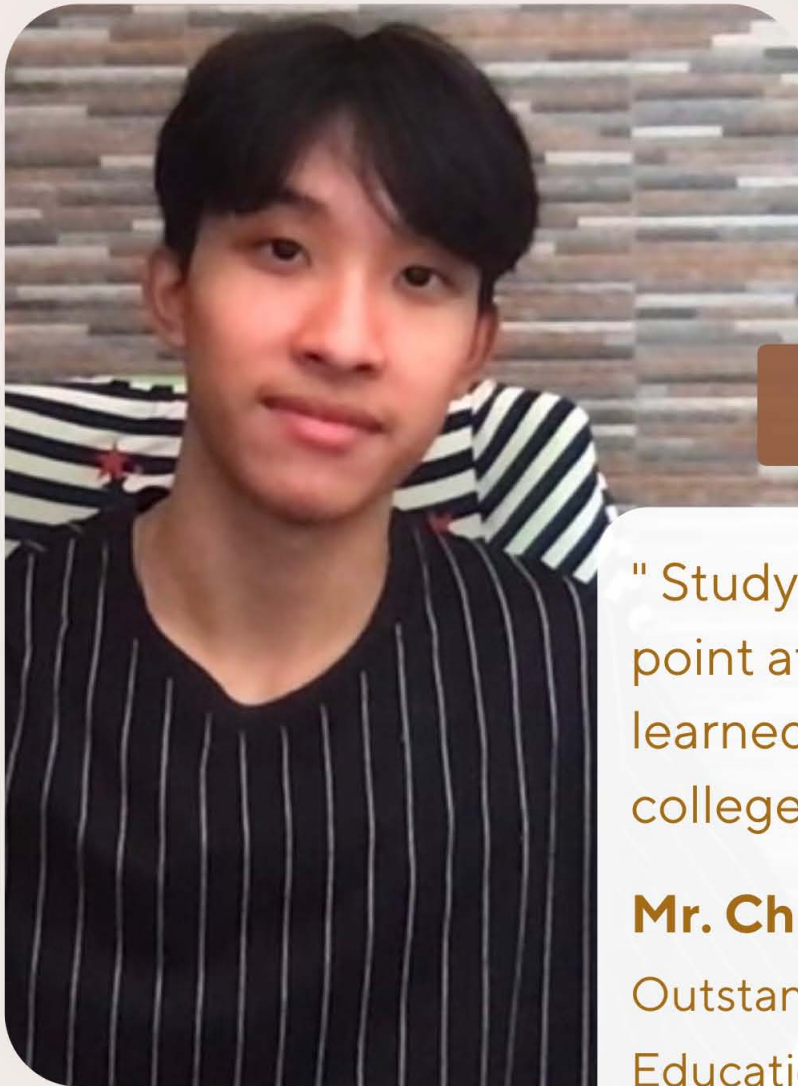
